- 2. Design a Character T-shirt Book Report (see attachment) that represents the main character from the book that was read. <u>Please follow the attached instructions carefully</u>. Points will be deducted for book reports that do not follow these instructions (see Rubric).
- 3. Fill in all of the information. Be sure to write neatly.
 - a. Write the main character's name across the middle of the T-Shirt.
 - b. Write the title, author, illustrator, and your name in the spaces provided at the bottom of the T-Shirt.
- 4. Be creative! Use crayons/markers to make it colorful. (Additional decorations may be used.)
- 5. Cut out the T-Shirt and glue it to another piece of colorful paper for presentation and/or display.
- 6. This book report is due on: <u>Friday, September 29th</u>. Points will be deducted for book reports turned in after the due date.
